Semi-annually, The Royal Educational Foundation (REF) invites all teachers and other interested parties to apply for the mini-grants in a sum not to exceed \$1,000. The mini-grant program embodies the Foundation's mission to promote excellence, support opportunities that enhance teaching and prepare students to become tomorrow's leaders.

Projects may be for single or multiple classrooms, interdisciplinary and, multi-grade, or school-wide. The Foundation's goal is to support a wide range of educational interests and creativity. Applicants must be accessible either by phone or via the Internet to answer questions that may be posed by the Foundation in connection with grant request. **Grant money cannot be used:**

- for teacher compensation;
- to purchase equipment otherwise available from the district; or
- to pay for the cost of bus transportation.

All applicants awarded a mini grant will be required to submit captioned photos taken during the course of their project upon completion and must answer a short evaluation form.

The application is simple and can be found on the Foundation's website www.pjref.org or from any school building principal. **Deadlines for submission are June 1 and December 1**. Minigrant award recipients will be announced at either the Superintendent's Conference in September (if submitted in June) or a building faculty meeting in January (if submitted in December) by *The Royal Educational Foundation*.

Each project must be approved by the principal of the building in which it will take place before submission to the Foundation. Mini grants are for short-term projects only. If your project is a long-term one, there is a different application which can also be found on the website.
